

UNIONIZATION RATES FOR 2010

Unionization Rates for 2010:

- There are 4.2 million unionized workers in Canada.
- The ratio of unionized vs. non-unionized increased slightly from 29.5% to 29.6%.
- 28.3% of men and 30.9% of women were unionized.
- The public sector is the most unionized sector at about 70%. It increased slightly in 2010. Health care is the highest segment of the sector, at 73%.
- In Ontario, the unionized rate declined from 28.1% in 2009 to 27.9% in 2010.
- Public-sector coverage declined from 75.1% in 2009 to 74.8% in 2010.
- In Ontario, the hourly wage for employees covered by a collective agreement was \$26.58 (vs. \$21.30 for non-unionized).
